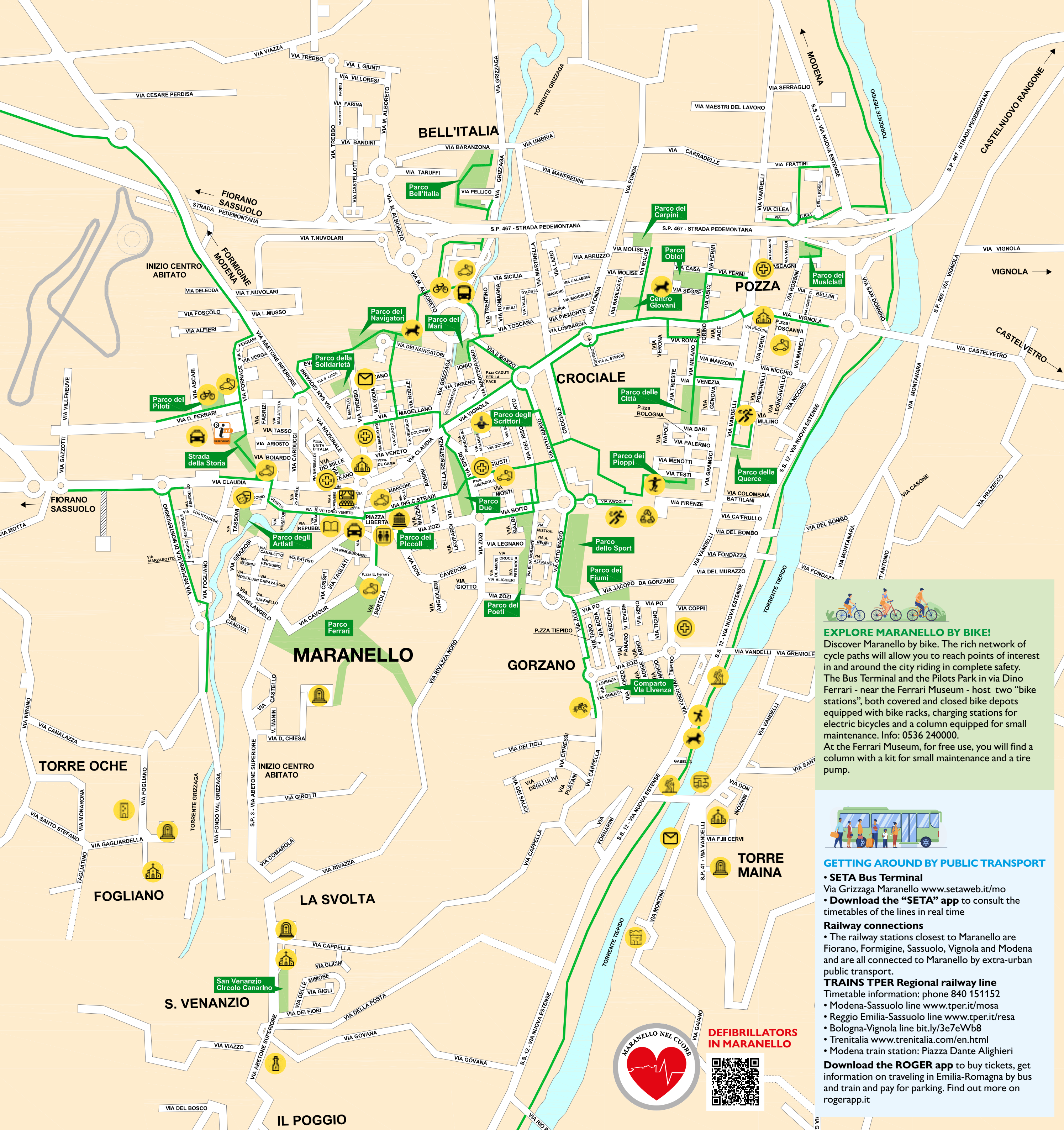

EXPLORE MARANELLO BY BIKE!

Discover Maranello by bike. The rich network of cycle paths will allow you to reach points of interest in and around the city riding in complete safety. The Bus Terminal and the Pilots Park in via Dino Ferrari - near the Ferrari Museum - host two "bike stations", both covered and closed bike depots equipped with bike racks, charging stations for electric bicycles and a column equipped for small maintenance. Info: 0536 240000. At the Ferrari Museum, for free use, you will find a column with a kit for small maintenance and a tire pump.

THE HORSE ROUNABOUT (CENTRE)

The centre of Maranello welcomes you with the symbol of the Ferrari myth, a wrought-iron sculpture modeled by the gardeners of the Municipality that soar above the roundabout between Via Claudia and Via Abetone Inferiore. Discover the history of the Cavallino on the lectern in the sidewalk next to it.



ONE PASSION, MANY EMOTIONS

The life of Enzo Ferrari has inspired a lot of artists: many artworks are set in the city. In Piazza Libertà you can see a maxi panel with the reproduction of his signature. Next to the Town Hall soars Marino Quartieri's work, a column where one can read the most significant stages in the life of Enzo Ferrari. About 200 meters from Piazza Libertà, at the entrance of the Ferrari Park, stands the sculpture by Franco Carloni "My world in the world".



RED GARDEN

In Maranello even the flowerbeds pursue art and aesthetics. The gardeners of the Municipality have furnished a green oasis with a real Ferrari body! Are you ready for a photo?



FERRARI MUSEUM

A visit to the Ferrari Museum is each time a unique experience: the engines are the centre of a story made of victories, twists, art, culture and design. The exhibitions are constantly evolving and each visit is a new discovery! Outside you can see Structuration F1, the sculpture created by the artist Jean-Yves Chevalier. The car set in the metal grid is Michael Schumacher's F2002.



SCUDERIA FERRARI

The most competitive soul of the company is hidden behind the elegant curves of this building: here research and innovation create the cars that compete in the F1 championship.



FERRARI HISTORICAL ENTRANCE

It is from here that in 1947 Enzo Ferrari came out driving the 125S, his first Ferrari. Much has changed since then but the entrance of via Abetone Inferiore 4 remains the same. On June 18th, 2020 at 6:30 am the Historical entrance was the starting point of an exciting lap by Charles Leclerc through the city streets with his F1. A unique event that can only happen in Maranello!



A FERRARI IN THE CITYHALL

What other Town Hall hosts a Ferrari "575 Maranello"? Ready for a photo shoot? In Piazza Libertà you can charge your phone for free at the "Bersò", relax at the book sharing corner, go shopping or choose among the many restaurants, pizzerias and bars that Maranello offers. You can ask for information at the Town Hall or at the Maranello Café for bus timetables as well.



ENZO FERRARI AUDITORIUM

Events, cinema, theater, concerts, screenings, meetings: here you can experience with the people of Maranello the thrill of watching a F1 Grand Prix live and share joy and passion of the most important event for Ferrari fans.



DESIGN, CULTURE AND SILENCE: MABIC

It's called MABIC and is the public library of Maranello: a building with a unique and captivating design, the result of the project of architects Arata Isozaki and Andrea Maffei, a jewel set in the city centre. The shaped windows follow the curved lines of the building and offer a view over the walls covered with greenery, creating a fusion between inside and outside. MABIC is the centre of the cultural activities and hosts events throughout the year.



THE WIND TUNNEL

The Wind Tunnel represents the encounter between architect Renzo Piano's design and Ferrari research technology. The beauty of the architectural complex is emphasized in the evening when the building is enlightened by the factory night lights.



FERRARI FACTORY ENTRANCE

The "Cittadella Ferrari" is an extraordinary architectural complex with buildings dedicated to specific elements of the design and construction of the cars. Particularly valuable are the architectural structures by Renzo Piano, Massimiliano Fuksas, Jean Nouvel, Marco Visconti and Luigi Sturchio. The ticket to the Ferrari Museum allows you to purchase the ticket for the panoramic tour of the factory and the track by shuttle.

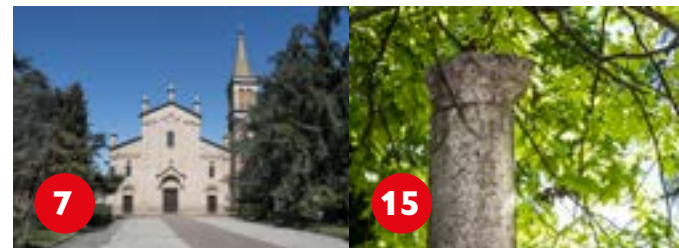
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THE "ROAD OF HISTORY"

The "Road of History" starts next to the Ferrari Museum and takes you through the park: along the red route seven panels tell the story of Ferrari and Maranello.

"THE SITES OF ENZO FERRARI"

The itinerary "The Sites of Enzo Ferrari" reveals the treasures of the city that link the museum to the centre: you will find yourself in the most important places of the legend of the Prancing Horse and its city. Let yourself be guided by the directions: they will take you to the next stage!



ST. BIAGIO CHURCH / ROMAN COLUMN

In the centre stands Saint Biagio's church, patron saint of Maranello, inaugurated in 1899. It is tradition that the bells ring to celebrate every time Ferrari wins a Grand Prix. The Roman Column is older, the remains of which are visible in the flowerbed near the centre roundabout.



THE PRANCING HORSE (VIA GRIZZAGA)

Since 2003 you can admire in the roundabout of via Grizzaga the steel sculpture (5 meters high and 800 kilos weight) by the Albanian sculptor Helidon Xhixha, depicting the prancing horse, symbol of Ferrari.



"ALFREDO FERRARI" HIGH SCHOOL

Enzo Ferrari often said: "Each factory should have its own professional school to prepare its technicians for their future job". In 1963 his wish came true: a unique school was born on the national scene, with teaching materials always updated thanks to the close collaboration with the Ferrari factory. This relationship between school and business still continues today.
